The children worked in teams with checklists to identify animals by their feet, fins, or wings and their coverings. Engaging activities included guessing animals from close-up eye photos. We learned about the Bird of Paradise's impressive dance and how Galápagos iguanas escape snakes by diving into the sea.

After the museum, we returned to the park for a final play in a pirate ship themed play area, before getting back on the coach to return to school. It was a day full of discovery, fun, and learning in the heart of Nice!
