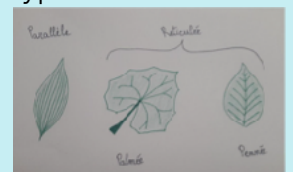
## Fête des associations

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## The Great Stories

Five Great Fundamental Stories staged by Maria Montessori are presented to children in order to open their curiosity and provide knowledge

- The story of the universe,
- The coming of life,
- The coming of humans,
- The story of writing,
- The story of numbers.

These stories are a tool that serves to nourish the imagination and reasoning of children to inspire them to want to go further and know more.

They serve as a basis for learning in all subjects. It is also a framework on which children can rely and reference. They will clarify and structure their thoughts so that they can make their own connections.

The goal of these stories is to inspire children, to arouse their curiosity, but above all to create a connection in their learning.

As the stories are in chronological order from the Big Bang to us, they will realize that they too belong to these stories, that they are the heroes and that we are all connected to each other as well as our ancestors.



## "The half an hour read"

In order to give everyone time to read for themselves, we organize regular reading times. This is a daily time, shared collectively, for personal reading: approximately 30 minutes are devoted to a reading break so that everyone can indulge in the book of their choice.
